## Cycling as a Transport Mode

### Informal Meeting of EU and EFTA Transport Ministers

On October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015, the Luxembourg Presidency of the European Union will organize the first informal meeting of Transport ministers dedicated exclusively to cycling as a transport mode.

18h30	Start of bike « parade » from the Conference Centre to Cercle Cité, 1800m over flat terrain through the historical centre of Luxembourg city. (Busses will be available as an alternative.)
